



Frequently Asked Questions:

- If I attend the Practical Course, must I do the Theory Certificate? *No. These are optional and a bonus addition to the Practical Course.*
- Do I have to pass the Instructor Skills Award to gain the Level 4 College Certificate? *Yes, but so long as you are eligible, you can enrol to study for it.*
- Once I have the Level 4 College Certificate, can I pass Level 5? *You are only eligible to study for Level 5. The Diploma recognises Practical as well as Theoretical knowledge, so you can only complete the Level 5 Diploma once you have also passed your 'Advanced' Practical.*
- I already have my Advanced Practical, can I go straight to Level 5? *Currently, all students are required to pass the first stage Level 4 Examination.*
- Can I take the Examination off-site? *Harper Adams Policy is that a Harper Adams invigilator must be present.*
- Examinations will normally take place during the practical PDTI course, however, additional exam sittings may be arranged if numbers are sufficient.
- What does it all cost? *Practical Instructor Awards revolve around the week-long residential course (allow for full accommodation and meals). PDTI Levels 1 & 2 cost £25 each, and the PDTI Level 3 & 4 cost £40 each, however they are free to PDTI members. The Diploma is only available through the PDTI for £200 plus attendance on further practical courses (discounted for Tutoring involvement)*
